### **Our Commitment to Child Safety**

Wollondilly Razorbacks Basketball Club is committed to providing a safe, positive, and inclusive environment for all children and young people involved in our programs.

We recognise our responsibility to promote the safety, welfare, and wellbeing of children and young people and to ensure they are protected from harm. Child safety is a shared responsibility and is central to everything we do as a club.

### **Child Safe Standards & Compliance**

Wollondilly Razorbacks Basketball Club complies with all relevant child safety legislation and guidelines in New South Wales, including:

- **NSW Child Safe Standards**
- **Working With Children Check (WWCC) requirements**
- **Mandatory Reporter obligations**
- **Basketball NSW Member Protection Policies**
- **Active Kids Program requirements**

All coaches, officials, volunteers, and committee members who work with children are required to hold a **current Working With Children Check** and comply with our club's child safety policies and codes of conduct.

### **Safe & Supportive Environment**

We are committed to ensuring that children and young people:

- Feel safe, respected, and supported
- Are treated fairly and without discrimination
- Can participate in basketball in a positive, inclusive environment
- Are encouraged to speak up if they feel unsafe or uncomfortable

Our programs focus on skill development, teamwork, enjoyment, and respect — both on and off the court.

## **Codes of Conduct**

All members of Wollondilly Razorbacks Basketball Club are expected to adhere to appropriate standards of behaviour.

This includes:

- Treating all children with respect and dignity
- Maintaining appropriate professional boundaries
- Using positive and constructive coaching methods
- Refraining from any form of bullying, harassment, or inappropriate behaviour

Breaches of conduct are taken seriously and will be managed in accordance with club and Basketball NSW policies.

## **Reporting Concerns**

The safety of children is our priority. Any concerns, suspicions, or disclosures relating to the safety or wellbeing of a child should be reported immediately.

Concerns can be raised with:

- A club committee member
- Basketball NSW
- Relevant authorities where required

All reports will be handled sensitively, confidentially, and in line with legal obligations.
